

#### **Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow**

- James Whitcomb Riley's 1885 poem "Little OrphantAnnie" served as the inspiration for Harold Gray's popular 1920s Chicago Tribune comic strip of the same name.

- Meehan, Annie's liprettist, thought Annie was a "rotten idea," but was convinced by Charnin's interest in "the richness of the character Annie herself—the lost, wandering child." He constructed the story to be a child's odyssey-like quest for her missing father and mother.

- Annie received its world premiere on August 10, 1976, at the Goodspeed Opera House in Connecticut.


- The original Annie was quickly replaced with a tougher young actress that of was playing Pepper.

- McArdle opened the show at Broadway's Alvin Theatre (now the Neil Simon) on April 21, 1977.

- Annie went on to run for 2,377 performances and helped launch the career of replacement Annie, Sarah Jessica Parker.

- In 1982, Annie hit the big screen in a \$50 million adaptation staring Carol Burnette and a Broadway all-star cast.

- In 1997 Annie was revived on Broadway and starred Nell Carter as Miss Hannigan. It only ran for 239 performances.
